## **DEFENSIVE GUIDELINES**



**CALLING FOR THE BALL** 

When a player is going to field a ball ... call, loudly "BALL, BALL, BALL".

PRIORITY RULES (Who has priority, first responsibility to field a ball and why.)

BUNT

When two, or more, fielders are going for the ball and any one can get it, the <u>fielder moving towards-first base</u> has priority over the fielder moving away from first base.

- 3b over pitcher
- -- P 1B
- C over 1BBunts in front of home plateBunts in front of home plate

GROUND BALL When two fielders are going for the ball and either can get it, the <u>fielder</u> moving towards first base has priority over the fielder moving away from first base.

- 3B over SS
- SS over 2B

**FLY BALL** 

When two fielders are going for a fair fly ball the following priorities apply:

- Outfielder over Infielder (easier to catch coming in than going out)
- Middle over Wing/Corner (simplify communication, reduce guesswork)
  - CF over either LF or RF
  - SS over 3B
  - 2B over 1B
  - SS over 2B
- Corners (3B or 1B) over PITCHER
