

## NMCYSA – Division Rules for 2016

- **T-Ball Division– Coach-pitch & batting tee**
  - A 10-inch safety ball (soft, cushioned) is used, such as the Easton Incrediball
  - For every half-inning, the entire team will bat and outs do not count. Even if a batter/base runner is out, they remain on base. The base runners can advance only one base per hit ball, except for the last batter in the line-up, who gets to run around all of the bases (a home run)
  - The line-up order can change each inning
  - Each player will be given up to five (5) pitched balls to try to hit. After that, the ball will be placed on a tee for the batter to hit
  - Base runners can not leave the base until the ball leaves the pitcher's hand. They are not out if they do, but after the play is over the coach should remind the base runner to wait until the ball leaves the pitcher's hand
  - Base stealing is not allowed
  - Games are up to 40 minutes. No inning will start with 5 minutes or less left in the game. Once an inning starts, it is played to completion
